Strengthening Uganda-China Relations: Meeting Between Hon. Gen. Odongo Jeje Abubakhar and H.E Zhang Lizhong

Minister of Foreign Affairs, Hon. Gen. Odongo Jeje Abubakhar, met with H.E Zhang Lizhong, Ambassador of the People's Republic of China on July 17th 2024.

During the discussions, Ambassador Zhang highlighted the preparations for the upcoming Forum for China-Africa Cooperation (FOCAC) meeting in Beijing from 3rd to 8th September 2024.
